In memory of Jacob Hall, the Berkeley County Local Emergency Planning Committee has formed the Stop The Bleed Subcommittee to ensure that Stop The Bleed kits and proper training are provided to members within our community. Our goal is to ensure that the kits and knowledge are accessible to the bystanders who can act immediately. Be The Help, Until Help Arrives.

From 2016-2018, there were 77 active shooter events around the country resulting in 1,156 casualties.

The STB kit contains CAT tourniquets, chest seals, bandages, medical gloves, and trauma shears

**16% of these events occurred in schools.**

**Trainers will host one-hour classes.**

Uncontrolled bleeding is the most **significant preventable cause of death** during an active shooter situation.

Students will have the opportunity to learn how to tie a tourniquet, pack a wound, and apply direct pressure.
